



Cat. No. 0555 and 0753 L.E.D. Surface Mount Dome Lights

These lights are designed for use on vessels operating on a nominal 12 or 24 volt system. (See labeling on light).

In order to comply with '72 COLREGS and the U.S. Inland Rules, the following must be adhered to:

MOUNTING INFORMATION

Read all instructions before proceeding.

- 1). For proper light selection make sure the voltage label on the light matches the vessels supply voltage.
- 2). Attach supply connections to the light, making sure to wire in accordance with both A.B.Y.C. Standard E-11* and U.S. Coast Guard Safety Standards for Boat Electrical Systems (33 CFR 183)*. If supplied with two black leads, these lights are not polarity sensitive; otherwise connect red to positive and black to negative electrical supply.
- 3). Fig. 0555 Dome light: use #8 mounting screws.
- 4). Fig. 0753 Dome light: use #10 R.H. mounting screws,
- 5). These lights use white L.E.D.'s and therefore are not serviceable.
